## REFRESHER CERTIFICATE FOR GLOBAL MARITIME DISTRESS AND SAFETY SYSTEM RESTRICTED OPERATOR

### TARGET GROUP

This course has been designed for captains and officers of the Merchant Marine as well as people holding certificates in Nautical Fishing who can be officers of the watch on ships under the Global Maritime Distress and Safety System in Zone A1 and who need to revalidate their certificate.

### TRAINING

**Objective:** Update knowledge and management of radio equipment that are part of the GMDSS in zone A1.

**Law:** The course is adapted to the requirements of the International Convention on Training, Title and Guard for Seafarers (STCW 1978/95) with the Manila Amendments 2010, RULE IV/2; SECTION A-IV/2 and ERC/DEC/ (99)01. ITU-RRCC.47.22 – IMO 1.25. STCW course endorsed in Spain by the DGMM.

### DURATION

The course consists of 8 certified hours, it's delivered over a period of 1 day.
