**Requirements:** Hold a current VTS IALA C0103-1 certificate.

### TRAINING

**Objective:** At the end of the course, trainees will be able to carry out correctly the role of an IALA VTS training instructor.

**Maritime legislation:** Since 6 July 2011, the Jovellanos Centre for Comprehensive Maritime Safety has been authorised by a resolution of the Directorate-General of the Merchant Navy to provide the 'Vessel Traffic Services Training Instructor Course C0103-4'.
