COURSE POSITIVE PRESSURE VENTILATION

TARGET GROUP

This course has been designed for people who belong to fire-fighting services and emergency brigades in industrial facilities.

Requirement: Prior knowledge is required on the use of the SCBA equipment.

TRAINING

Objective: The course provides teams involved in fire-fighting and emergencies with the basic knowledge of the principles and techniques regarding ventilation that apply to vent toxic gases and fumes, as well as to manage and use the necessary teams to act safely and effectively.

DURATION

The course consists of 21 certified hours, it's delivered over a period of 3 days.
